
YAYA CHANG & Le Cercle de l'Art

As an artist, I frequently find myself immersed in solitary pursuits, grappling with doubts at every turn. A significant aspect contributing to this struggle is the financial instability inherent in the artistic endeavor. However, the notion of Le Cercle, a collective of like-minded individuals, offers a beacon of hope during these challenging times. The prospect of receiving a consistent salary for my creative endeavors not only provides vital mental relief but also reduces the inevitable pressure to plan and allows me to live a productive artistic life.

By joining my Circle of Collectors:

- You actively support artistic creation by contributing to the establishment of a monthly income for me, the artist.
- You have the opportunity to carefully select and acquire artwork and pay over 12 month installments.

How it works

Acquiring Art over 12 months

Small Format

8 artworks priced between €50 to €70 per month which makes an artwork with a price of €600 to €840 including of taxes

Medium Format

7 artworks priced between 80€ and 90€ per month which makes an artwork with a price of 960€ and 1080€ including taxes.

Large Format

4 artworks priced between 120€ and 250€ per month which makes an artwork with a price of 1440€ and 3000€ including taxes.

Bio

Ariane "Yaya" Chang (b. 1986) is a Chinese-French-American artist raised in New York and Hong Kong and based today in Paris. She is self-taught and works in oil, watercolor, acrylic and ink painting. Her eclectic artwork draws inspiration from her co-existing cultures and identities. She believes that it is nourishing to work in multiple spheres, inhabiting different selves in the same body. Yaya graduated magna cum laude from Cornell University and holds an MBA from ESSEC. She is the proud mother of two girls.

Themes

Why these disparate themes are deeply connected:

My artwork delves into my personal experience, encompassing the archetype of the woman warrior, the Amazon, navigating daily life both externally and internally. Externally, it reflects the demands of my job, my art, my social circles and the face I present to the world—a facade of strength, composure, and emotional resilience. Internally, I am softer, pensive, overanalytical and quiet. This dichotomy is evident in the portrayal of intensity and softness in my artwork, and is often difficult to reconcile and integrate. My Amazons and Female Gaze series, are expressed through bold colors, strong strokes, and heavy materials. My Routine and Horses series are more intimate depictions in softer, more delicate tones. I need both dimensions to exist, and move forward, encapsulating the complexity and multifaceted nature of womanhood.









Female Gaze

In this graphic series, I embark on a profound exploration of female objectification and the dynamics of the male and female gaze. I carefully select and manipulate images from vintage pornographic magazines dating back to the 1970s, which I, heavily pregnant at hte time, procured from the quaysides near my old studio on Ile Saint Louis in Paris. It serves as a commentary on the enduring complexities of gender dynamics and the pervasive influence of objectifying representations of femininity.

Amazons

The Amazons embody my daily experience, reflecting the relentless balancing act I and many women face—managing career, family, health, and personal growth while contending with constant scrutiny. This sensation of navigating multiple realms simultaneously is a recurring theme in my complex life (if you know me personally, you see). Originally inspired by influential women in my life, the concise, selective strokes that depict feminine faces have evolved into vibrant canvases portraying various aspects of womanhood intertwined with my own experiences.

Routine

In an age in which notifications constantly pop up from a suite of social media applications, it is a challenge in our daily lives to sit in silence and focus on a single task. The Routine Series is an attempt to wield control over my busy life as a mother, artist and full-time worker. Routine is not a drag but a necessary regimen that propels us forward into the days which will eventually compose our entire lives. These pieces represent how I start my day, often in a notebook or stray pieces of paper.

Horses

Drawing horses has always been my passion. They effortlessly flow from my pencil, offering tranquility and spontineity. My artworks are often monochromatic in shades of blue, reflecting my affinity for this calming hue. I found solace in painting these magnificent creatures during my pregnancy with my daughter, using it as a means to unwind and connect with my inner creativity.






Interior shot of Paris Routine Triptyque



My chop:

I sign my work using my maiden name, "Chang" or "Zhang" using my collection of Chinese chops (stamps) that I have designed and acquired over the years. They are engraved in stone and I use them for my Routines often. I do this out of practicality and I get satisfaction out of pressing hard onto the paper and getting this strong signature. I don't stick to one because I am often traveling or putting my drawing supplies in different places all the time, so it is whichever chop is available at the time.











When I'm sketching a horse, I become completely absorbed in the process. Transitioning to drawing another horse, if there's one to be drawn, requires me to momentarily break free from the trance-like state I was in while drawing the first one. 
